WCB Premium Rates

2020 average premium rate will increase three cents per \$100 of payroll



WCB has released its premium rates for 2020.

The average premium rate will increase three cents of \$100 of payroll to \$1.14 from \$1.11 in 2019. "Increased claim costs, sluggish employment and slower wage gains have all contributed to the

increased claim costs, sluggish employment and slower wage gains have all contributed to the increase," reported WCB. "The premium rate is required to cover the costs of injuries for Alberta's workers is \$1.33 but we are using the Accident Fund to offset costs and avoid burdening employers with a considerable increase in rates. This move will help minimize the impact on Alberta employers in this challenging economy, while maintaining worker benefits."

One contributing factor to the increase is the Economic Loss Payment for injured employees who can't find suitable work. WCB Alberta created the Training on the Job (TOJ) initiative in order to address this. If you are interested in more information, please contact info@amta.ca.
