

Parking in Reverse

To park forward or reverse? That is the question



- Parking areas are full of pedestrians so extra caution and focus are needed
- When you reverse park, you are moving into a designated space with no pedestrian traffic
- Reverse parking causes a safer environment for exiting as sight lines are greater and traffic is in front of you
- You are generally not in a hurry when arriving at a destination compared to departing
- Finally, should anything mechanical happen to your engine or battery, your hood is facing front creating easier access for repair

Whether you choose to park in reverse or not, create conversation surrounding parking areas, including the fact collisions increase in congested areas and a higher percentage of pedestrians are injured by vehicles backing up.
