Certificate of Recognition (COR) is available to companies with 11 or more employees.

To Achieve COR

Step 1: Register your company in the WCB Partnerships in Injury Reduction Program

Step 2: Successfully complete the AMTA's Health and Safety System Building (HSSB) course

Step 3: Develop and implement a health and safety management system that meets OHS standards

Step 4: Select a Certified AMTA Consultant Auditor

Step 5: Have an audit completed and achieve a passing mark (80% overall score, with no less than 50% in any one element) and submit to AMTA for review

To Maintain COR

The COR is valid for three years from the date of issue, providing that all maintenance audit requirements are met. The date the audit is completed on site in the certifying year, is the COR issue date/anniversary date.

COR maintenance audits can be conducted internally by an Internal COR Auditor or a Certified AMTA External Consultant.

Become an Internal COR Auditor

Step 1: Successfully complete the AMTA's Health and Safety System Building (HSSB) course

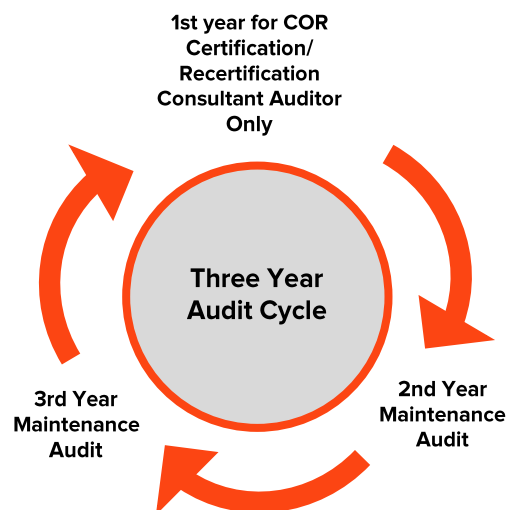
Step 2: Successfully complete the AMTA's COR Auditor Course

Step 3: Complete and submit a qualifying maintenance audit within 3 months of completing your COR Auditor training

Once you achieve your COR Auditor Certification you must maintain it by conducting 2 maintenance audits within every 3 year cycle and attend COR auditor training every 3 years.

WCB account holders in General Trucking (50714), Specialty Hauling (50701), and Garbage Collection and Disposal (57901) automatically qualify as Associate Carrier members.

Audit review fees apply to non-members.
